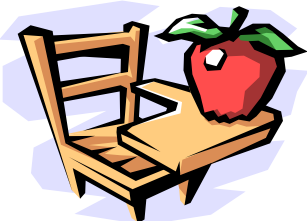


Julene Messick, M.Ed., Instructor NNU Innovative Instructional Series

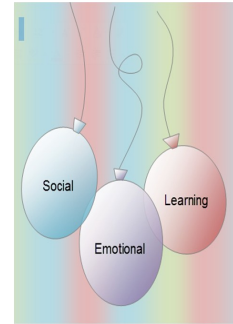
Educators have enjoyed her enthusiasm for education and the various presentation techniques that she uses in the instruction of adults.

Learning with the Heart

The *Learning with the Heart* workshop is designed to provide an overview of the importance and the critical role the heart plays in effecting our emotional experience. Tools are provided that present opportunity for development of higher-order thinking skills, learner readiness, decision making and test-taking. Social and emotional behavior is a strong component in how a student learns. The goal of the *Learning with the Heart* In-service Workshop course encourages educators to become engaged in the curriculum modules that provides methodology that guides best practices. Educators will "Explore the Es" of a proven learning environment and will use methods to 1) Excite, 2) Enhance, 3) Engage, 4) Experiment, 5) Exchange and 6) Explore opportunities for their students and their own educational enhancement.



Course Format

Week 1 Activity: Addressing anger - 2 Hour Workshop at school or district.

Weeks 2 through 6 are self-paced independent study. At the completion of the activity an email is sent to the Instructor

Week 2 Activity: Keys to successful social and emotional learning. Email response to the Instructor.

Week 5 Activity: The importance of Multiple Intelligences and the use of Learning Styles. Email assignment to the Instructor.

Week 6 Activity: Linking Social and Emotional Learning with the Common Core. Email assignment to the Instructor.
